# **Eastspring Investments –** Asian Low Volatility Equity Fund (the "Fund")



Eastspring Investments - Asian Low Volatility Equity Fund is referred to as the 'Fund'.
The Fund invests in equities and equity-related securities and is exposed to the risk of market price fluctuations.

The Fund aims to generate total returns in line with Asia Pacific ex Japan equity markets, via a combination of capital growth and income, but with lower volatility. The Fund will invest primarily in equities and equity-related securities of companies, which are incorporated, listed in or have their area of primary activity in the Asia Pacific ex-Japan Region. The Fund may also invest in depositary receipts, including ADRs and GDRs, debt securities convertible into common shares, preference shares and warrants.
