


TARGET FUND ASSET ALLOCATION*

The Lipper Leaders Ratings System is a set of tools that guide investors and their advisors to select funds that suit individual investment styles and goals. It uses investors-centred criteria to deliver a simple, clear description of a fund's success in meeting certain goals, such as preserving capital or building wealth through consistent strong returns.

Lipper Leader ratings are derived from highly sophisticated formulas that analyse funds against clearly defined criteria. Each fund is ranked against its peers based on the metric used (such as Total Return or Expense), and then the top 20% of funds in that ranking receive the Lipper Leader designation. Lipper Leaders measures are not predictive of future performance, but they do provide context and perspective for making knowledgeable fund investment decisions.

FUND MANAGER'S COMMENTARY

Emerging market (EM) equities, as measured by the MSCI EM index, rose in April, helped by a weaker US dollar, and outperformed developed markets.

Equities across the emerging and developed world experienced significant swings following "Liberation Day" on 2 April, which saw US President Donald Trump announce sweeping tariffs on imported goods. The tariffs were larger and broader than expected, although they were later suspended for 90 days for most countries, allowing negotiations to start. This helped share prices to recover.

Mexico was the top-performing index market, as the country faced no new trade tariffs on 2 April. Brazil was also notably strong, aided by local currency strength, while India continued to perform well, supported by a rate cut, an improving inflation outlook and a weaker US dollar. Korea, Malaysia and Indonesia also posted returns that beat the index.

China underperformed, as its retaliatory response on tariffs escalated over the month. Turkey was the largest faller in the index in US dollar terms, given the weaker lira, ongoing inflationary pressures and an unexpected rate hike mid-month.
